

Age limit for JKKK, JKPP chairmen raised to 69, says Najib

The age limit for chairmen of Village Development and Security Committees (JKKK) and their federal counterparts JKPP has been raised from 65 to 69 years.

Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Razak announced this today, but said it was subject to their health status.

“Do not practise favouritism, if we want to increase (the age limit), we extend it to all except for those whose health does not permit or are no longer capable.

“I am for the age limit to be raised to cater to two additional terms that is to 69,” he said at the JKKK and JKPP Malaysia 2015 gathering in Kuala Lumpur.

He said he hoped that it would resolve the age limit issue which was raised by the groups. – Bernama, December 3, 2015.
