

Zahid Arrives in Beijing for Four-Day Working Visit

BEIJING, Feb 1 (Bernama) -- Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Ahmad Zahid Hamidi arrived at Beijing Capital International Airport at 9.50 pm (local time) tonight to begin a four-day working visit.

This is his first working visit to China as Deputy prime Minister to further enhance bilateral ties between Malaysia and China.

He was met on arrival by Malaysia's Ambassador to China Datuk Zainuddin Yahya; Malaysian Embassy in China Deputy Chief of Mission John K. Samuel and diplomatic officials based in Beijing.

Ahmad Zahid is scheduled to pay a courtesy call on the leaders of China and hold meetings with Central Political and Legal Affairs Secretary of the Communist Party of China Meng Jiangzhu and Minister of Public Security, Gou Shengkun.

The discussions will focus on the e-visa system implementation, regional security and efforts to address terrorism and radicalization.

Ahmad Zahid will also spend time with Malaysian students studying in Beijing at a dinner which is expected to be held on Feb 3 (Wednesday).
