

**Top cop says no Isis camps in Malaysia**

Inspector-General of Police Tan Sri Khalid Abu Bakar today confirmed that no training camp of the Isis militant group existed in Malaysia.

He said, however, Malaysia should take precautionary measures following claims that a training camp of a militant group was found in the southern Philippines that openly supported the Isis ideology.

"The militant group training camp is not Isis's training camp but it is found to have expressed its open support for the Isis and this is seen as dangerous," he said at a function in Kuala Lumpur, on the possibility of the existence of an Isis training camp for adults or children in the country.

Yesterday, Bukit Aman Special Branch Director Datuk Seri Mohamad Fuzi Mohd Harun revealed that at least eight Malaysian children were recruited and trained to be Isis fighters in several camps in Syria and Iraq.

Khalid said efforts to bring back these children were difficult as their minds had been poisoned by the Isis ideology.

But he said the police would continue to stop Malaysians planning to go to countries like Syria from pursuing militant-linked training and knowledge.

Khalid urged all quarters, including Islamic religious schools to be cautious so as not to be influenced by the ideology. – Bernama, January 13, 2016.
