

**PM concerned over Kota Raya brawl**

Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Razak, in a Facebook post tonight, said he viewed with concern the brawl at the Kota Raya shopping complex yesterday over alleged cheating by traders and warned people against pursuing justice on their own.

If there were any instance of a commercial crime or cheating involved, it should be reported to the authorities who would take the appropriate action.

"Don't take the law into your own hands," was the prime minister's advice.

Najib was commenting on fighting, which broke out at Kota Raya yesterday that resulted in two people getting injured.

The brawl took place when some 20 men stormed a mobile phone shop.

The skirmish followed a press conference outside the complex by the Muslim Consumers Association of Malaysia (PPIM) to condemn traders who allegedly cheated customers.

Police, however, said the press conference by PPIM and the brawl that followed were unrelated.

Utusan Malaysia reported last week that a customer, allegedly locked up after a dispute with a mobile phone seller, had met the president of the Malay Army Veterans Association Mohd Ali Baharom, better known as Ali Tinju, and urged a boycott of Kota Raya traders to "teach them a lesson" in respecting customers. – December 21, 2015.
