

DAP should respect Malaysia's stance on Israel, says Zahid

Malaysia has a clear policy regarding diplomatic relations with Israel and DAP should not breach that, says Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Ahmad Zahid Hamidi.

He said the people's sensitivity with regard to issues associated with Israel should be respected.

In fact, he said, DAP's partners in the opposition did not share its view on the matter. "It is needless for me to name any party but I believe DAP should not consider the matter from only its viewpoint... it should look at it from the aspect of the sensitivity of the majority of the people in the country," he said.

Ahmad Zahid was asked to comment on a Perak DAP leader's reported criticism of Youth and Sports Minister Khairy Jamaluddin for denying visa to two Israeli windsurfers scheduled to compete in a tournament in Langkawi.
