

**Muhyiddin says barred from speaking at school event by 'certain parties'**

Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin said he was barred from speaking at a youth sports event held in a school in Subang Jaya today on "orders from certain parties".

Muhyiddin said in a Facebook posting that he had been invited by Community Sports Club Subang Jaya to launch a youth football game at SMK USJ4 in Subang Jaya this evening, and had gone to the event but was told there that he was not allowed to speak.

"Unfortunately, I was told the school have received orders from certain parties to direct the organiser not to let me speak.

"Never mind. I've been expecting this would happen," said Muhyiddin, who has fallen out of favour with the Umno leadership over his criticism of party president and Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Razak over alleged financial scandals.

Muhyiddin was dropped as deputy prime minister and education minister in a Cabinet reshuffle last July but remains Umno deputy president.

At the Umno general assembly in December, he was also barred from addressing party members when the party leadership abandoned the tradition of having the deputy president officiate the meetings of the Youth, Wanita and Puteri wings.

Muhyiddin said he still got the chance to meet members of the public at the sports event today even though he was not allowed to speak. – January 31, 2016.
