

PM And Sarawak CM Go on A Walkabout in Kubah Ria

KUCHING, March 11 (Bernama) -- Immediately upon arriving at the Kuching International Airport here, Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak went on a walkabout around the Kubah Ria complex area located on the Sungai Sarawak bank, here tonight.

The people who had thronged the complex were clearly excited in welcoming the presence of the country's number one leader at about 9 pm who was accompanied by Chief Minister Tan Sri Adenan Satem.

Also present were Works Minister Datuk Fadillah Yusof, and Sarawak Tourism and Housing Minister Datuk Amar Abang Johari Tun Abang Haji Openg.

Members of the public took the opportunity to shake hands, and in fact some took a selfie with Najib and Adenan, who later tasted the delicacies at the complex.

The complex, costing more than RM22 million, was completed in the year 2010 and housed 47 units of shops, 44 stalls selling food and drinks as well as a centralised atrium, and an open air eating area that can accommodate 500 people at any one time.

The prime minister and his entourage later left the complex at about 9.45 pm.

Najib is here for a three-day working visit to Sarawak, and tomorrow he is scheduled to launch the program 'Minda' (Inclusive Malaysia A Digital Nation) organised by the Ministry of Communications and Multimedia (KKMM) at the Kuching Waterfront, here.

He is also scheduled to officially open the beginning of construction work on the Pan Borneo Highway involving the route from Serian roundabout to Simpang Pantu at the site of Tebedu Driving Institute, Jalan Tangga Bypass, Serian, and go on several walkabouts on the following day before returning to the federal capital.
