

**Parliament: Malaysia Committed To Contribute Annually To Palestine via OIC, UNRWA**

KUALA LUMPUR, March 14 (Bernama) -- Malaysia is committed to make an annual contribution of US\$63,000 (RM258,411) to the Islamic Solidarity Fund (ISF) through the Organisation of Islamic Cooperation (OIC), the Dewan Rakyat was told Monday.

Deputy Foreign Minister Datuk Seri Reezal Merican Naina Merican said the contribution was to enable the organisation to carry out humanitarian missions for the Palestinians in Gaza.

"The government is also committed to make an annual contribution of US\$25,000 (RM102,547) to the United Nations Relief and Works Agency (UNRWA) from 2012 to 2017," he said in reply to Ahmad Marzuk Shaary (PAS-Bachok) during question time.

Reezal said in July 2014, Malaysia had given additional fund of US\$100,000 (RM410,177) to the OIC and UNRWA when Israel carried out its 'Protective Edge' operation, which resulted in the deaths of many Palestinians.

"Malaysia has always been committed, and would continue giving full support for the Palestinian rights and their fight to protect the Palestinian territory and the City of Al-Quds Al-Sharif," he added.
