

Malaysia, Bulgaria Ink MoU on Legal Cooperation Initiatives

PUTRAJAYA, March 28 (Bernama) -- Malaysia and Bulgaria today inked a memorandum of understanding (MoU) on legal cooperation initiatives.

The MoU was signed by Attorney-General Tan Sri Mohamed Apandi Ali and Bulgarian Foreign Minister Daniel Mitov at the Attorney General's Chambers, here Monday.

Attorney General's Chambers Malaysia (AGC) in a statement today said the MoU was aimed at establishing a platform for relations on legal cooperation between Malaysia, as represented by the AGC, and the government of Bulgaria, as represented by the Ministry of Justice.

"This MoU is not only a tool to strengthen the existing professional ties between the legal officers of both countries, but the cooperation is also an important forum for the exchange of information, experience, knowledge and best practices involving legal issues for the mutual benefit of both parties," it said.
