

**Appointing, Removing PM through Undemocratic Means Invalid – Ahmad Zahid

JASIN, March 4 (Bernama) -- Appointing or removing a prime minister through means other than the democratic system is invalid, said Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Ahmad Zahid Hamidi.

He said the other methods did not adhere to the ethics stipulated in the Federal Constitution and national legislation.

"I feel the laws must be obeyed and the democratic system we subscribe to must be respected. If any others were in power, surely they will not want something like this to happen to them.

"Do not do anything that goes beyond ethics if you are not comfortable. I am not referring to anyone in particular but we have to respect the law and constitution," he told a press conference here.

Ahmad Zahid was asked to comment on the Anti-Najib Campaign led by former prime minister Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad where a so-called Citizen's Declaration was signed calling for the ouster of Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak as the prime minister.

Earlier, Ahmad Zahid opened the Sungai Rambai Rural Transformation Centre here.

Melaka Chief Minister Datuk Seri Idris Haron and Rural and Regional Development Minister Datuk Seri Ismail Sabri Yaakob were also present at the event that was attended by over 200 people.
