

**Saudi Arabia not alone in facing Any Threat - Najib

KUALA LUMPUR, March 5 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak said Saudi Arabia was not alone in facing any threat following the formation of the Islamic Military Alliance participated by 34 countries.

Malaysia, he said, is part of the alliance formed by Saudi Arabia.

"The alliance gives a clear signal that the stability, security and position of Saudi Arabia in the Islamic world is very important to Malaysia and other Islamic countries," he said in his latest posting on his Facebook Saturday.
