

## **PMSP Wants Probe against Dr Mahathir**

PETALING JAYA, March 7 (Bernama) -- An organisation known as Pertubuhan Minda dan Sosial Prihatin (PMSP) wants the police to investigate former Prime Minister Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad over a statement he made at Pusat Alumni Universiti Malaya here last Friday.

Its deputy president, Zakwan Hafiz Ahmad Ansari claimed that Dr Mahathir was believed to have uttered seditious statements against Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak.

"We have lodged a police report so that the police can conduct investigation into the 'Save Malaysia Declaration' event last Friday," he told reporters after lodging the report at the Petaling Jaya district police headquarters here today.

Also present was PMSP president Ramesh Rao.

Last Friday, Dr Mahathir led a group of more than 50 people - including DAP advisor Lim Kit Siang and Selangor Menteri Besar Datuk Mohamed Azmin Ali - signed a declaration calling for Najib's ouster.

Also present at the event were former Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin, former Kedah Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Mukhriz Tun Mahathir and former MCA president Tun Dr Ling Liong Sik.

Zakwan Hafiz also said investigation should also be conducted against Muhyiddin for claiming that he had evidence on misappropriation by Najib.

Meanwhile, Ramesh claimed that there were attempts by some individuals to instigate the people to attend a gathering to call for Najib to step down this March 27.
