

Najib, Rosmah Attend Tunku Kurshiah College's Fund Raising Dinner

KUALA LUMPUR, April 9 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak tonight attended the Malay Girls College/Tunku Kurshiah College (TKC) Old Girls Association biennial fund raising dinner.

Najib was accompanied by his wife, Datin Seri Rosmah Mansor, who is also a former student of TKC in Seremban, Negeri Sembilan. Also present was TKC Old Girls Association president, Tan Sri Dr Rafiah Salim.

TKC in a press statement said the dinner aimed to raise funds to help TKC students and upgrade and improve facilities at the new campus in Bandar Enstek, Negeri Sembilan.

"This year, the association aims to raise at least RM200,000 which will be channeled to several projects in the college. Among the projects are the acquisition of a new school bus, building of two multipurpose sports courts," it said.

If the amount raised exceeded the target, the balance of the funds will be used for the 'Special Projects Students Programme' which was set up by the government to ensure financial aid to TKC students from families earning an income of below RM800 per month, the statement added.
