

**Dr Mahathir must commit to reform agenda, says PKR

Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad should commit to a reform agenda in his bid to remove Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Razak, said PKR vice-president Nurul Izzah Anwar.

She also said any matters on cooperation between Pakatan Harapan leaders and Mahathir would be answered tomorrow, in a joint press conference attended by the former prime minister and opposition leaders.

"Everything that we're doing right now has to be looking at the future of Malaysia. We are in a crisis and we must prioritise the need to implement institutional reforms.

"So every set of discussions and engagement must be based on a sincere commitment to reforms.

"If we are trapped by our own feelings of vengeance or anger or bitterness then we're not able to focus on the need for reforms," she said at the PKR headquarters today.

Earlier today, The Malaysian Insider reported that Dr Mahathir was [expected to lead a movement against Najib](#) after spending the past few days meeting a number of politicians and activists.

It has been learnt that Dr Mahathir will lead some 40 leaders to sign a declaration tomorrow, seeking the removal of Najib who has been prime minister since April 2009.

The declaration will be symbolically presented to a people's representative, followed by a news conference.

"Let's wait until tomorrow's press conference to know what's the official offer," said Nurul, who is Lembah Pantai MP.

"For me, the two key things, commitment towards reform and sincerity to realising it till the end. These are the prerequisites before anything can be said," she said, adding that Dr Mahathir's statement that he might have to share a cell with Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim was shocking.

Last week, Dr Mahathir said he could be Anwar's neighbour in the Sungai Buloh prison following police action to take his statement over a blog post criticising the leadership.
