"Recently, I read about Siti Nuraisyah's wish to meet with me. Alhamdulillah, we had the opportunity to meet last night in Sungai Nibong.

"Although what happened to her was poignant, I was amazed by her strong spirit in dealing with the test," the prime minister said on his Twitter and Facebook sites.

Najib also prayed that the student be given the strength and fortitude as well as blessed by Allah.

Siti Nuraisyah was on her way home from her school on a motorcycle with her stepsister Shamim Amira Roslan, 14, when the incident happened at about 3.30pm at Parit 16, Sungai Panjang.

Siti Nuraisyah when met by reporters last night expressed her happiness at having the opportunity to meet with the Prime Minister and described the meeting as 'a wish come true'.
