

**Only BN Has Clear-Cut Agenda to Strengthen Unity - Najib

KUALA KANGSAR, June 10 (Bernama) -- Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak said only the Barisan Nasional government had a clear-cut agenda to strengthen unity among the various races in the country.

The Prime Minister said BN believed such unity in diversity formed the basis for achieving developed nation status.

"BN has a clear-cut agenda and vision which we have explained to the people; we implement policies that can bring about unity in the country," he said at a programme with the Chinese community at Sekolah Menengah Tsung Wah here today.

He said "moderation" as practised by the BN government, was also in harmony with the 'Chung Young' or 'Wasatiah' concept.

Meanwhile, Najib said the government was aware of the importance of education to the Chinese community and had implemented policies and approaches in this regard.

The policies, he said, was not new and had been in place even while he was the Education minister.

"Education and the Chinese community are close to my heart; I respect the emphasis placed on education by the Chinese community," he said.

On Sekolah Menengah Tsung Wah, Najib said he would discuss with the state government on the allocation for the construction of a new administrative block for the school.

He also lauded the Perak state government's action to allocate about 1,000 hectares of land to nine private schools in the state over the last three years.

Also present at the programme was Perak Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Dr Zambry Abdul Kadir.
