

**Najib, Rosmah Partake In Bubur Lambuk Stirring In Pekan

PEKAN, June 11 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak and his wife Datin Seri Rosmah Mansor today attended the 'bubur lambuk' stirring programme organised by the Pekan District Women's Institute (WI) and Single Mothers Association.

Najib and his wife spent about 40 minutes at the programme held at their official residence, Sri Kenangan, in Peramu, here.

During the programme, Najib and Rosmah also stirred the bubur lambuk and poured some into containers to be distributed to the public.

Pekan District WI chairman Datuk Melati Ali told reporters that about 3,000 containers of bubur lambuk were prepared during the programme, which was held every year during Ramadan.

Melati said the bubur lambuk would be served to guests breaking fast with Rosmah at Sri Kenangan, as well as distributed to mosques in the district.

At the breaking-of-fast, Rosmah also handed out Raya contributions to 200 orphans in the Pekan parliamentary constituency, a traditional practice for her each Ramadan.

The event, which was attended by about 1,000 people despite the heavy rain, started with a religious talk by Ustaz Dzulkarnain Hamzah Al-Hafiz.
