

DPM Visits Kuala Kangsar By-election Media Centre

KUALA KANGSAR, June 12 (Bernama) -- Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Ahmad Zahid Hamidi today spent time to mingle with media representatives at the Kuala Kangsar by-election media centre.

He arrived at 4.45pm and spent about 30 minutes to look into the operation of the centre before making his rounds to meet media practitioners covering the by-election at the centre.

A total of 122 media representatives from various agencies involving the print, social and broadcasting media are involved in the by-election coverage since nomination day on June 5, until polling day on June 18.

Also present was Perak Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Dr Zambry Abd Kadir.

Ahmad Zahid, who is also UMNO deputy president, presented Aidilfitri contributions to all media and Information Department personnel on duty at the centre.

Polling for the Kuala Kangsar parliamentary by-election is scheduled on June 18, following the death its incumbent, Wan Mohammad Khair-il Anuar in a helicopter crash in Sarawak on May 5.

The by-election is a four-cornered contest between candidates of BN, PAS, Parti Amanah Negara (Amanah) and Independent.
