

Dr Mahathir's New Party Plan Proves His Lack of Confidence in Existing Opposition Parties

REMBAU, July 16 (Bernama) -- UMNO Youth has described the intention of former Prime Minister Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad to form a new party as a sign of his lack of confidence in the existing opposition parties.

UMNO Youth chief Khairy Jamaluddin said the failure of DAP, PKR and PAN (Parti Amanah Negara) in winning the Sarawak state election and both the Kuala Kangsar and the Sungai Besar parliamentary by-elections had prompted Dr Mahathir to set up a new opposition party as he knew he could not depend on the existing ones.
