KUALA LUMPUR, April 21 (Bernama) -- Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak today lamented that certain leaders who once championed nationalism were now soliciting foreign intervention in the country's domestic affairs.

"These people are willing to abandon principles, in fact, gamble away the nation's sovereignty purely for their personal agenda," the Prime Minister said in his latest post on his Facebook account.
