

PM Scheduled to Launch Pan Borneo Sabah Highway Project Sunday

KOTA KINABALU, April 21 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak is scheduled to launch the Pan Borneo Sabah Highway Project on Sunday, said Sabah Chief Minister Datuk Seri Musa Aman.

He said the launch would be held at Kampung Andus, Papar, at 10am and was expected to be attended by more than 20,000 people.

"The Pan Borneo Sabah Highway will be a safer, more comfortable and efficient infrastructure for the people, and will drive and boost economic and social development in Sabah.

"I invite the people from all walks of life to gather and witness the launch of yet another project to upgrade infrastructure development in the state for the people's wellbeing," he told reporters after the state legislative assembly sitting Thursday.

The 706-km highway is expected to change the Sabah infrastructure landscape and link the major cities in the state.

On the state assembly meeting, Musa expressed satisfaction over the commitment of the assemblymen, including from the opposition, in their participation in the four-day meeting from Monday for the wellbeing of the people in the state.

"It is our policy and stand as a responsible government to be open and appreciate and accept constructive suggestions for the wellbeing of the people and state," he said.
