

Perkasa Urges Government to Intervene In MISC Integrated Logistics Takeover

KUALA LUMPUR, May 25 Bernama) -- Malay rights group Perkasa is urging the government to intervene in the recent sale of MISC Integrated Logistics Sdn Bhd (MILS) to a non-Bumiputera company by Petronas subsidiary, MISC Berhad (MISC).

Its president Datuk Ibrahim Ali is concerned that the acquisition will affect 90 per cent of the 1,200 employees who are Malays and Bumiputeras.

"It is normal practise for new companies to lay off workers to reduce operating costs through rationalising programmes," he told reporters at Perkasa Office here, Wednesday.
