KUALA LUMPUR, June 27 (Bernama) -- The 43-year-long relationship between the United Kingdom (UK) and European Union (EU) came to an end after the UK voted to leave the bloc in a historic referendum with 52 per cent votes to 48 per cent.

The EU referendum that saw a turnout of 71.8 per cent, was held on Friday UK-wide to decide whether Britain should leave or remain in the 28-member state bloc.
