

Najib Breaks Fast With Terengganu Folks

KUALA NERUS, June 29 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak on Wednesday attended the breaking-of-fast event with approximately 16,000 residents from around Batu Rakit, here.

Also present at the event held at the Al Salam Mosque, Batu Rakit, were Terengganu Menteri Besar Ahmad Razif Abd Rahman, Higher Education Minister Datuk Seri Idris Jusoh and the state leaders.

Najib also joined the congregation for Maghrib prayers at the mosque.

Earlier, Najib spent about 15 minutes at Batu Enam Ramadan bazaar to buy traditional delicacies for the breaking of fast.

Meanwhile, the Prime Minister's wife Datin Seri Rosmah Mansor attended a separate breaking-of-fast event at a hotel here and presented Hari Raya donation to 204 orphans.

When met by Bernama, one of the recipients, eight-year-old Nor Amirah Baharuddin, whose father died of a heart attack last year, expressed joy for having met Rosmah and receiving 'duit Raya' from the first lady.

She said the money would be given to her mother for safekeeping and to buy new clothes.

Meanwhile, teacher Khamsiah Abdul Karim who accompanied the children to the event, in appreciating the sustenance for the children, expressed the hope that such events would be continued by the leaders.

"I have been attending these functions with the children for several years now and this month has been quite lavish compared to other months.

"I am here with them not only because it is my duty but it pleases me to see them happy," she said.
