

OIC Condemns Acts of Terror in Saudi Arabia

KUALA LUMPUR, July 5 (Bernama) -- The Organisation of Islamic Cooperation has strongly condemned the terrorist attacks in three cities across Saudi Arabia yesterday that killed four security officers and injured five.

OIC Secretary-General Iyad Ameen Madani said those who carried out, planned or supported these attacks were simply carrying out desperate acts to undermine the security and stability of Saudi Arabia as well as the security and stability of the region and the Islamic world.

"Any person who takes out his or her life, kills and terrorises innocent people, and commits such crimes in the holy month of Ramadan and in Al-Madinah Al Munawwarah, close to the sacred mosque of the Prophet, negates being a Muslim and refutes every Islamic value," he said in a statement.....
