

Opening Ceremony of Wisma Ceylonese in Seremban by Prime Minister Postponed

SEREMBAN, May 6 (Bernama) -- The opening ceremony for Wisma Ceylonese here by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak, this Sunday, May 8 has been postponed to an indefinite date.

President of the Negeri Sembilan Ceylonese Association, S. Kumarasamy said the postponement was a mark of respect for the AS350 helicopter tragedy which occurred while it was travelling from Betong to Kuching, Sarawak, yesterday.

The helicopter was carrying six passengers including Wanita head of Sungai Besar UMNO division Datuk Noriah Kasnon, who was also the Deputy Minister of Plantation Industries and Commodities.

"I was just informed of the postponement. The new date will be announced later," he told Bernama when contacted here today.

The three-storey RM3.3 million building in Jalan Sungai Ujong is owned by the NSCA, and Negeri Sembilan Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Mohamad Hasan is also expected to be present for the ceremony.
