

RM1 Mln to Build Breakwater at Kuala Baram Proof of BN Govt's Concern – Ahmad Zahid Bernama

MIRI, May 6 (Bernama) -- Datuk Seri Dr Ahmad Zahid Hamidi said the RM1 million allocation to build a breakwater in Kuala Baram is proof that the BN government cares for the fishermen in the area.

"I understand the fishermen's situation very well because my area in Bagan Datoh is also a coastal area...they have to deal with strong waves that erode the shoreline day by day.

"So the allocation is a reflection of the BN government's concern for the fishermen," he said while speaking at a gathering with the People's Volunteer Corps (Rela) and opening of the Kampung Batu 1, hall in Kuala Baram here today.

Also present were Senadin BN candidate, Datuk Lee Kim Shin who is also Infrastructure Development and Communications Assistant Minister, and Rela director-general Datuk Kamariah Mohd Noah.

At the event, Ahmad Zahid also announced an allocation of RM300,000 to rebuild the fence at Masjid An-Naim in Lutong.

He said he would also propose to the Agriculture and Agro-based Industry Ministry to consider the fishermen's request for at least one month to net shrimps in Miri.

Meanwhile, Lee hoped voters would not be influenced by misleading postings being circulated in the social media about the 11th state election.

"Don't be influenced by the disparagement spread by irresponsible quarters in the social media. At least get some clarification first. Report it to us," he said.

Lee, 63, is defending his Senadin seat against DAP's Dr Bob Baru Langub and PBDS Baru candidate, Philemon John Edan in the polls tomorrow.
