

UK Allocates RM4.85 Million Prosperity Funds for Projects in Malaysia

KUALA LUMPUR, Sept 14 (Bernama) -- The UK Government has allocated Prosperity Funds worth 913,500 pound (about RM4.85 million) for eight projects in Malaysia in 2016/17, the largest amount ever allocated since the fund was introduced in 2011.
