JOHOR BAHRU, Oct 18 (Bernama) -- Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Ahmad Zahid Hamidi today took time off to attend the Johor UMNO Liaison Committee meeting here.

Ahmad Zahid, who is also UMNO vice-president but discharging the duties of deputy president, arrived at 8.15pm accompanied by Umno vice-president Datuk Seri Hishammuddin Tun Hussein and Johor Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Mohamed Khaled Nordin, who is also State UMNO Liaison chief.
