

**Najib Visits Former UMNO Information Chief Tan Sri Hussein Ahmad**

PASIR MAS, Aug 20 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak Saturday visited former UMNO Information chief Tan Sri Hussein Ahmad at his home in Kampung Lemal here.

Najib, who is also UMNO president, spent approximately 45 minutes catching up with 81-year-old Hussein, who suffered from minor stroke.

Also present were Kelantan UMNO Liaison Committee chairman Datuk Seri Mustapa Mohamed, Deputy Minister in the Prime Minister's Department Datuk Dr Asyraf Wajdi Dusuki and Pasir Mas UMNO chief Datuk Hanafi Mamat.

Earlier, Najib attended the Leader-Meets-People programme and the launch of Tumpat UMNO delegates' meeting at Sekolah Kebangsaan Kubang Batang, Tumpat.

Speaking to reporters later, Hussein, who held the post of UMNO Information chief from 1982 to 1996, thanked the prime minister for his concern and visit.

As an UMNO veteran, Hussein also called on all UMNO members to strengthen the party and observe the basis of its struggle.

He also advised former UMNO members to return and re-join the party for the sake of Malay solidarity.
