BANGKOK, Sept 21 (Bernama) -- Malaysian Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak's recent visit to Thailand has resulted in a closer coordination between both countries on the issue of the southern Thai conflict.

Thai deputy prime minister Gen Prawit Wongsuwan said, both countries were able to improve their coordination on the issue following Najib's Sept 8-9 visit for the Malaysia-Thailand Sixth Joint Annual Consultation.
