

**Malaysia's Views, Concerns on Syrian Conflict Well Received By UN - Zahid

KUALA LUMPUR, Sept 23 (Bernama) -- Members of the United Nations (UN) Security Council received Malaysia's views and concerns well on the bloody conflict in Syria, said Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Ahmad Zahid Hamidi.

In addition to the members of the Security Council, he said Malaysia's views were also well-received by the leaders of the countries involved in the process of finding a solution in the troubled country.
