KUALA LUMPUR, Sept 23 (Bernama) -- Datuk Seri Mohd Najib Tun Razak hopes that members of the public will participate in the online survey on Budget 2017 which is being conducted at bajet2017.najibrazak.com/survey.

A total of 8,352 suggestions on Budget 2017 were received since the website for the purpose was opened to the public on Sept 5 until it was closed last Wednesday.

The categories which received the most suggestions were employment, education, public transportation and infrastructure, taxation, business and finance, as well as housing and urban living.

Budget 2017 will be tabled in Parliament on Oct 21.
