

Najib Makes Official Visit to Germany Tomorrow

KUALA LUMPUR, Sept 25 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak will make an official visit to Germany beginning tomorrow until Wednesday and is expected to have a meeting with German Chancellor Dr Angela Merkel.

Wisma Putra said in a statement Sunday that the meeting between the two leaders would discuss bilateral, regional and multilateral issues.

"In addition, the visit was also expected to enhance capacity building between the two nations, especially in the fields of trade and investment, education and vocational training, agriculture, science and technology, and infrastructure development," the statement said.

Besides the bilateral meeting, Najib would also hold a dialogue session with key leaders of the business sector in Germany and meet with the Malaysian community and students in that country.

During the visit, the Prime Minister would be accompanied by his wife, Datin Seri Rosmah Mansor, International Trade and Industry Minister Datuk Seri Mustapa Mohamed, Plantation Industries and Commodities Minister Datuk Seri Mah Siew Keong and senior government officials.
