

PM Najib Meets Chinese President Xi

BEIJING, Nov 3 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak led a Malaysian delegation at a meeting with Chinese President Xi Jinping at the Diaoyutai State Guest House here Thursday.

Najib and Xi later had a four-eyed meeting before adjourning for a dinner hosted by Xi and his wife Peng Liyuan in honour of Najib and Datin Seri Rosmah Mansor at the same venue.

Diaoyutai State Guest House, which means Fishing Pavilion, was formerly a royal retreat in one of the famous historic gardens in the western suburbs of Beijing.

It is named after Emperor Zhangzong (1168 AD-1208 AD) of the Jin Dynasty who built a pavilion for fishing here some 800 years ago.

Najib arrived here on Monday for a six-day official visit to China, his third since 2009.
