

Najib's Accounts Comprehensively Probed, No Law Broken - Aide

KUALA LUMPUR, Aug 30 (Bernama) -- The funds in Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak's accounts have been comprehensively investigated, and multiple authorities have ruled that no law was broken, according to an aide.

Datuk Seri Tengku Sariffuddin Tengku Ahmad, Najib's press secretary, said in a statement today that the foreign minister of Saudi Arabia had also confirmed that the funds in the prime minister's accounts were a donation from the royal family of Saudi Arabia. ?

"The Malaysian Anti-Corruption Commission even went to Saudi Arabia and examined all the legal documents and interviewed the donor's representatives," he said.

The statement was in response to former deputy prime minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin's latest allegations against the prime minister.....
