

Ahmad Zahid Approves RM9.5 Mln Allocation to Build Two Mosques in Jasin

JASIN, Sept 4 (Bernama) -- Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Ahmad Zahid Hamidi Sunday approved a RM9.5 million allocation to build two mosques in Jasin.

Ahmad Zahid, who is also UMNO vice president but discharging the duties of deputy president following the sacking of Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin, said the mosques will be built in Kampung Tehel (RM4.5 million) and the other one in Bemban (RM5 million).

He said the allocation would be disbursed after the process of land acquisition for both projects had been completed.

"I'm a grassroots leaders, I came from the bottom... I understand the needs of the local population," he said when opening Jasin UMNO division delegates meeting here today.

Ahmad Zahid also approved a RM500,000 allocation to upgrade the air conditioning system of the Alamanda Hall where the meeting was held.

Also present was Jasin MP Datuk Ahmad Hamzah, who is also Jasin UMNO chief.
