

Ahmad Zahid Makes Personal Contribution to Haroon Mosque in Bangkok

BANGKOK, Aug 5 (Bernama) -- Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Ahmad Zahid Hamidi who is on a two day working visit to Thailand took time to perform Friday prayers at Haroon Mosque here with the local Muslims.

Ahmand Zahid also made a personal contribution to the mosque located in Jalan Charoen Krung in the heart of the Thai capital.

"The personal contribution is to build the women's prayer area of the mosque," he told reporters before returning to Malaysia.

The contribution was handed over to the Grand Imam of the mosque, Abdul Ahad, after the Friday prayers.

Joining the Deputy Prime Minister for the Friday prayers were senior officials of Malaysia's Ministry of Home Affairs, Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Malaysian media members covering his visit.

After the Friday prayers, Zahid had a meeting with his counterpart Gen Prawit Wongsuwan, who is also the Minister of Defence. Earlier in the morning, he had also met with another Thai Deputy Prime Minister, Wissanu Krea-ngam.
