

Pahang to use e-LPS System to Monitor Land Encroachment in Cameron Highlands

PUTRAJAYA, Aug 9 (Bernama) -- Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Ahmad Zahid Hamidi presented the e-LPS system (electronic-temporary occupation licence) to Pahang Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Adnan Yaakob to help the authorities monitor and supervise land development activities for agricultural purposes.

The presentation of the e-LPS system to the Pahang government was held at Perdana Putra, here today.

The Natural Resources and Environment Ministry in a statement today said the e-LPS system was to ease the process of monitoring duplication of applications for temporary occupation license (TOL).

The system enables effective monitoring and enforcement activities since development had led to a higher demand for land in Cameron Highlands.

"The e-LPS system is an initiative towards automation of enforcement to curb encroachment of forest reserves for cultivation.

"The Pahang Land and Minerals Office can also identify illegal activities and preserve the greenery at Cameron Highlands," he said.

Through the system, new applications, renewal of TOL, expiry date of TOL or permit, status of applications can be processed online.

"The presence of the Global Information System and Global Positioning System (GPS) in the e-LPS will enable effective and efficient monitoring of land encroachment of forest reserve," he said.
