

**Be Concerned About the Lot of Muslims in Other Countries - PM

KUALA LUMPUR, Dec 10 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak said Muslims in Malaysia must be concerned about the fate of fellow Muslims in several countries.

He said the Prophet's words in the stories of At-Tabrani and Al-Hakim which stressed on the need for Muslims to be concerned about the affairs of other Muslims was a starting point for the rise of Malaysians in voicing out their protest on the oppression taking place.

"So, responding to the exhortations, we rise to voice our solidarity and concern on the fate of oppressed Muslims like in Palestine, Kashmir and the Rohingya in Myanmar.

"We are compelled to admonish and pressure those responsible with numerous approaches so that the persecution can be stopped," said Najib.

He said this in his message in conjunction with Prophet Muhammad's birthday on Dec 12, which was uploaded on his official blog najibrazak.com., Saturday night.

In the meantime, Najib also urged Muslims to endeavour to find the best way to channel aid for the oppressed.

The Prime Minister also invited Muslims to continue to be close to Allah in prayers to find solutions to the suffering of the Rohingya Muslims which has become prolonged.

"We pray that Allah gives fortitude and strength of faith to our Muslim brothers who are being tested with difficulty where ever they are.

"A Maulidur Rasul greeting to all Muslims in this country. May the celebration this year boost our capability and concern towards the struggles of Prophet Muhammad," he added.
