

Thai Government Approves Measure to Help Low Income Earners

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BANGKOK, Nov 22 (Bernama) -- Thai Prime Minister Gen Prayuth Chan-o-cha has announced an allocation of 12.75 billion Baht (RM1=8.04Baht) to assist low income earner nationwide.

About 5.4 million low income earners in Thailand, according to him, will each receive between 1,500 Baht to 3,000 Baht, which will be disbursed through their bank account between Dec 1 and 30.

"The measure will stimulate the economy as the government has also launched similar measures to help the farmers," he told reporters after chairing a Cabinet meeting here today.....

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
