

Malaysia, Cambodia Sign Mou to Boost Cooperation in Agriculture

SERDANG, Dec 9 (Bernama) -- Malaysia and Cambodia today signed a memorandum of understanding to strengthen cooperation in agriculture.

The MoU was signed by Malaysian Agriculture and Agro-based Industry Minister Datuk Seri Ahmad Shabery Cheek and Cambodian Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries Minister Veng Sakhon.

The signing took place at the Malaysian Agriculture, Horticulture and Agrotourism (MAHA) 2016 exhibition here.

Sakhon said to Bernama the MoU would pave the way for Cambodia to learn a great deal from Malaysia which was better developed in terms of agriculture.

"The cooperation will cover research and development, exchange of personnel in training and human development as well as sharing of information and experience," he said.

The MoU would also enable the two countries to explore new areas of cooperation, particularly in stepping up marketing of agricultural products, he added.
