

Refer to PAC report on 1MDB, Muhyiddin told

Second finance minister says he is ‘tired’ of answering questions from the opposition on 1MDB even though they had already been explained.

KUALA LUMPUR: Former deputy prime minister Muhyiddin Yassin should just refer to the Public Accounts Committee (PAC) report on 1MDB’s debts, says Second Finance Minister Johari Abdul Ghani.

He said this in response to Muhyiddin’s call to Prime Minister Najib Razak to respond to claims that currently, 1MDB didn’t have any bank loans or short-term loans.

Yesterday, Muhyiddin said that Najib, who is also the finance minister, had failed to explain several other matters, including how much 1MDB still owed and if it would be able to settle all its debts without the government’s assistance.

Muhyiddin, who is Parti Pribumi Bersatu Malaysia president, also wanted to know how 1MDB would generate income to settle its debts now that it had liquidated its assets.

Speaking to reporters on the sidelines of a community event, Johari said he was “tired” of answering questions from the opposition on 1MDB even though they had been explained.

“I’m tired of answering when the PAC report and Parliament has explained it,” he said, adding the PAC report had already explained 1MDB’s issues in detail.

He acknowledged that 1MDB did have its problems in relation to its business model and management.

“Any party has the right to criticise but this won’t solve the problem because all parties have to find a solution to develop 1MDB’s assets.”
