

Najib Arrives For A Two-day Working Visit To Kelantan

KOTA BHARU, March 11 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak arrived at the Sultan Ismail Petra Airport, Pengkalan Chepa here, at 6.20 pm today for a two-day working visit to Kelantan, starting today.

Also on hand to receive him were International Trade and Industry Minister Datuk Seri Mustapa Mohamed, Kelantan Federal Development Department director Datuk Makhtar Mustapa and Kelantan UMNO leaders.

The Prime Minister is scheduled to hold a meeting with UMNO leaders and members at a hotel here tonight.

Tomorrow, as early as 9.30 am, the Prime Minister would visit the houses of three residents in Bachok in a Let's Help The People Programme.

He would also attend a briefing from the East Coast Economic Region Development Council (ECERDC) at the East Coast Rail Line project (ECRL) Site in Jelawat, Bachok.

Najib was then expected to attend a ground-breaking ceremony for the Bachok Hospital and the launching of the Let's Help The People programme in Kampung Bator, Bachok.

In the evening, the Prime Minister is scheduled to open the Kota Bharu Urban Transformation Centre (UTC) before departing to Universiti Malaysia Kelantan (UMK), Pengkalan Chepa here to attend the 2050 National Transformation Programme (TN2050).
