

## **Rosmah Launches Book On Therapeutic Sensory Stimulation Garden**

KUALA LUMPUR, April 13 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister's wife Datin Seri Rosmah Mansor today launched a special book on the uniqueness and benefits of therapeutic sensory stimulation garden.

The book titled 'Therapeutic Sensory Stimulation Garden (TSSG) : An Introduction by Bakti-Mind Project', is the first of its kind in Malaysia and offers information about the garden located at the Universiti Malaya Medical Centre (UMMC).

The book is a collaborative effort of the Welfare Association of Wives of Ministers and Deputy Ministers (Bakti), Malaysian Information Network on Disabilities (Mind) and UMMC Rehabilitation Medicine Department.

According to head of Bakti-Mind project Datuk Dr Zaliha Omar, the book was aimed at educating the public on the need and benefits of sensory garden as an alternative rehabilitation treatment.

"It emphasise on the need to stimulate eight senses, namely the five conventional senses, and three suprasenses, which are space, emotional and spiritual," she told Bernama after the launch at UMMC.

The 143-page book was authored by Zaliha and UM Faculty of Built Environment senior lecturer Dr Hazreena Hussein and is now available at Bakti Building in Taman Tun Dr Ismail at RM66 each.
