

Najib Arrives In Sandakan To Start Two-Day Visit To Sabah

SANDAKAN, March 2 (Bernama) -- Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak arrived here tonight to begin his two-day working visit to Sabah.

The special aircraft carrying the prime minister and his wife, Datin Seri Rosmah Mansor, landed at the Sandakan Airport at 9.05 pm.

They were welcomed by Chief Minister Datuk Seri Musa Aman, his deputy Tan Sri Joseph Pairin Kitingan and several state ministers.

Tomorrow, Najib is scheduled to officiate the Hardcore Poor Housing Programme in Lupak Meluas here, before joining the congregation at the Lupak Meluas Wasatiyyah Mosque for Friday prayer.

In the afternoon, the prime minister will go on a walkabout at the Sandakan Harbour Square before heading to Kota Kinabalu.

On Saturday, Najib is scheduled to launch the Pan Borneo Sabah at Sekolah Menengah Kebangsaan Sindumin Sipitang and go on another walkabout at Tamu Putatan before leaving for Kuala Lumpur.
