

Najib Extends Condolences To Tungku Assemblyman's Family

KUALA LUMPUR, March 25 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak has extended condolences to the family of Tungku assemblyman Datuk Mohd Suhaili Said, who died at the Gleneagles Hospital here of liver cancer. He was 56.

"My condolences to the family of Datuk Hj Mohd Suhaili Said, the assemblyman for Tungku has died. May Allah bless his soul. Al-Fatihah," the Prime Minister said in his official Twitter site @NajibRazak today.

The remains of Mohd Suhaili were laid to rest at a grave behind his residence in Kampung Remang, Tungku, at 2.20pm today.

Suhaili, who was also Sabah Islamic Religious Council (MUIS) chairman, leaves behind wife Dayang Sofia Datu Jamiuddin and six children, four sons and two daughters.

In the last General Election, Suhaili won the Tungku seat after defeating PKR candidate Johani Abd Halim by a majority of 5,484 votes. He obtained 7,848 votes while Johani 2,364 votes.
