

Raja Muda Of Selangor Presents Aidilfitri Contributions To Orphans

MELAKA, May 28 (Bernama) --The Raja Muda of Selangor, Tengku Amir Shah Sultan Sharafuddin Idris Shah Sunday presented Aidilfitri contributions to 54 recipients from the Sultan Salahuddin Abdul Aziz Shah Orphanage (RAYSS), Tanjung Kling here.

The contributions totalling RM16,200 was from the Darul Ehsan Islamic Foundation (YIDE) with each recipient receiving RM300.

Also present were Melaka Islamic Religious Council deputy chairman and RAYSS chairman, Datuk Yaakub Md Amin and YIDE chairman Datuk Mohd Adzib Isa.

Sultan Sharafuddin Idris Shah is the patron of YIDE which was established in 2011.

RAYSS manager, Maznah Abdol said the contribution was very significant for the occupants of the orphanage to prepare for the coming Hari Raya Aidilfitri celebrations.

"The Raja Muda's effort to present the aid to the orphans proves he is concerned about the plight of the less fortunate and the underprivileged," he told reporters at the event.

In the meantime, Mohd Adzib said this was the fourth time YIDE is allocating contributions to RAYSS which previously was under the responsibility of the Selangor Islamic Religious Council's Treasury.

Meanwhile, a recipient, Hafidz Irfan Muhidin, 14, said he was thrilled to receive money from the Raja Muda and intended to save the money for future use.

"I am happy not only for the opportunity to receive a contribution from him, but also to have met and shook hands with him," said the second of three siblings.

Amirul Firhan Asren, 13, said this is the second year he had met the Raja Muda and was thrilled to receive the contribution.

"I am very grateful to him for giving me and my friends the Raya contributions and I also intend to keep the money to further my studies," said the aspiring comic artist.
