

DPM Breaks Fast With KDN Staff At Shah Alam Mosque

SHAH ALAM, May 31 (Bernama) -- Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Ahmad Zahid Hamidi today broke fast with Home Ministry (KDN) employees at the Tengku Ampuan Jemaah Mosque in Bukit Jelutong here.

Also present were Urban Wellbeing, Housing and Local Government Minister Tan Sri Noh Omar and Selangor police chief Datuk Seri Abu Samah Mat.

Earlier, Ahmad Zahid, who is also Home Minister, had attended an "Assimilating Noble Values" programme with Selangor KDN staff at the mosque.

The programme organised by KDN was attended by about 200 guests comprising officers and personnel and their families as well as friends of departments and agencies under the ministry and the congregation present at the mosque.

Selangor is the third destination of the programme after Terengganu and Negeri Sembilan.

At the ceremony, Ahmad Zahid also presented contributions to 100 orphans.

The Deputy Prime Minister later went to the Kota Damansara Mosque in Petaling Jaya for Isyak and terawih prayers and thereafter joined the congregation for light refreshments (moreh)
