

## **King Presents Zakat To 600 Orphans**

KUALA LUMPUR, June 17 (Bernama) --The Yang di-Pertuan Agong, Sultan Muhammad V tonight attended a breaking-of-fast ceremony with 600 orphans from around the Klang Valley, organised by the Pilgrims' Fund (TH).

On arrival at Istana Negara, Sultan Muhammad V was greeted by TH chairman Datuk Abdul Azeez Abdul Rahim and its chief executive officer, Datuk Seri Johan Abdullah.

After breaking fast, the His Majesty joined more than 600 worshippers in performing the Maghrib prayer led by Istana Negara surau imam, Nik Ridhuan Nik Mohamad. This was then followed by dinner.

At the event, Sultan Muhammad V also presented zakat amounting to RM90,000 (RM150 per person) to orphans aged 10 to 17 years old.

He later joined the orphans to perform Isyak and Tarawih prayers headed by Istana Negara assistant religious officer Ustaz Zulkefli Salleh.
